Seton Hall freshman **Troy Spencer** (High Point, N.C.) was named BIG EAST Conference Golfer of the Week on Thursday.

Last weekend, Spencer led the Pirates to a third place team finish at the Towson University Invitational. For the tournament, Spencer fired a 1-over-par, 74-69-74-217 to tie for fifth among 90 individual golfers. He finished only six strokes behind Kent State's John Hahn for the individual crown. Spencer's 217 is the best three round score of his career. His second round 69 marks the second time in his career that he has shot lower than 70 strokes in a single round.
