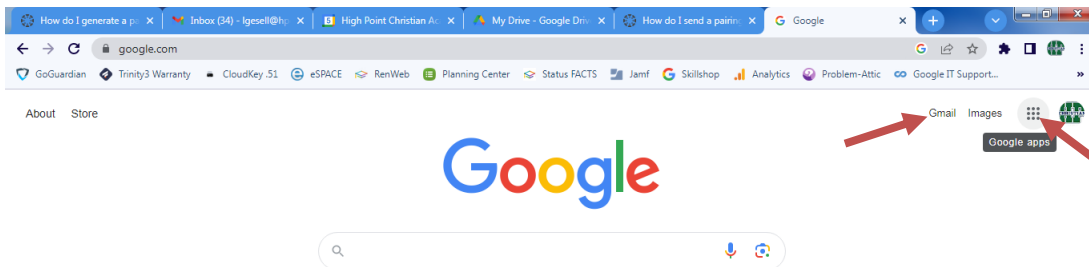


1 On a computer, go to Google.com and log in to your account

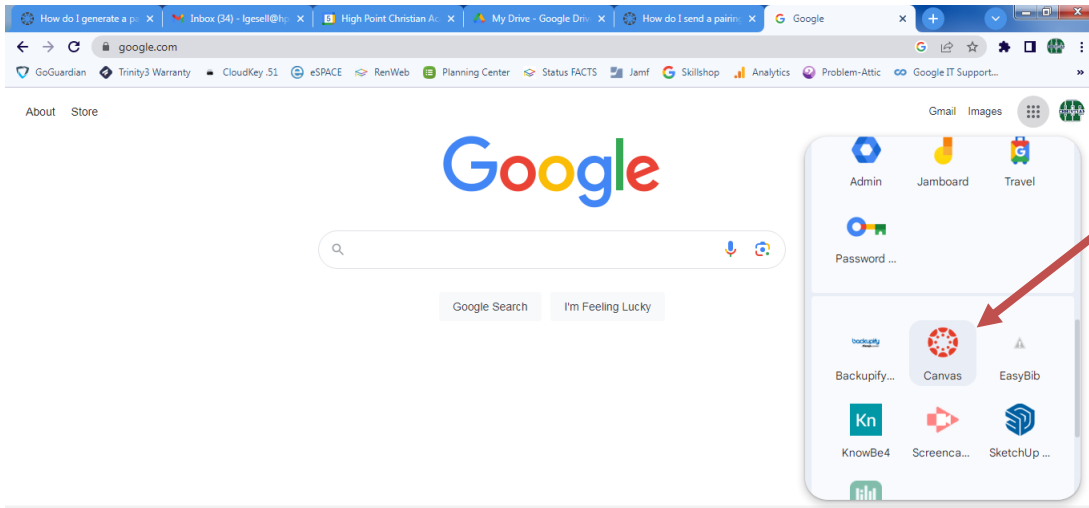
Use your school email address and password.
The email address will end in @hpcacougars.org

2 Gmail and the Google Apps Menu (9 dots)

Click on Gmail for your email messages,
and click on the Google apps menu (9 dots)



3 Scroll to the bottom and click on the Canvas icon



4 The student is now automatically logged in to Canvas

There are no additional login credentials for Canvas.

1 Download the Canvas Parent App (Blue)



2 Create an account: use a pairing code -or- a QR code

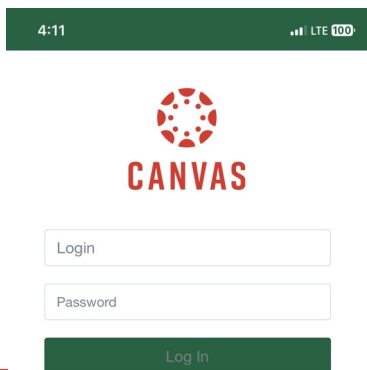
1. **Pairing Code** - click on Find your School. Use this option if you will get an alpha-numeric pairing code from your child's account—see #5 below.



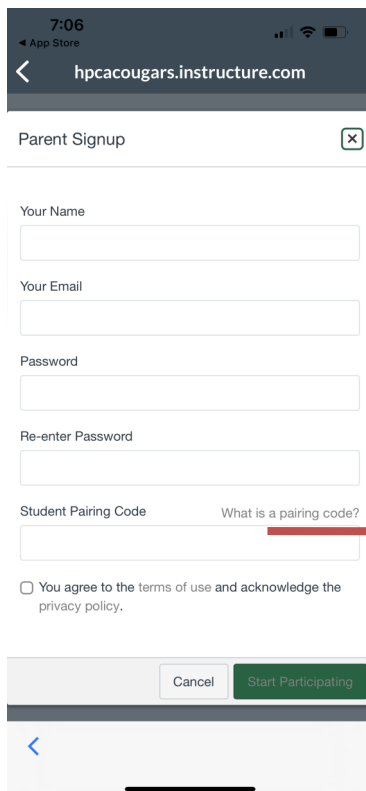
2. **QR Login** - When your child is logged in to their Student Canvas account, you can use the QR pairing code (From a computer, Student clicks Account, QR for mobile login. From a phone app, Student clicks Menu, Settings, and then Pair with Observer.)
If you use QR Login, steps 3-5 are not necessary.



3 Click on Create Account



4 Enter Parent Login Info



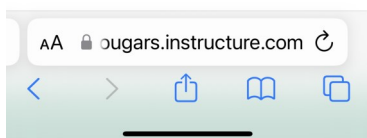
5 Get Pairing Code

- Click on left menu -- Account, Settings. On the right side, click Pair with Observer. This will generate an alpha-numeric pairing code.



1 Log in to your Canvas Account on a Chromebook or computer


Log in to Google using the Chrome browser and then access Canvas via the menu (9 dots)

2 Click on Account and QR for Mobile Login




